Dear Neighbors:

Head-Royce School is in the process of installing solar panels on the hillside above our athletic field. This Saturday, September 23rd, our outside contractor (Carbon Lighthouse) will be working on the hillside beginning at 9:00 a.m., with work continuing until the early afternoon. Between 9:00-10:00 am, workers will be cutting and grinding into the hillside with hand-held power tools. This work will be followed by a period of excavator operation, involving trips up the hillside, digging and dropping dirt. The excavator operation is expected to continue until the early afternoon. You may hear intermittent beeping sounds throughout the morning, as a legally-required warning mechanism will engage whenever the excavator is in reverse. Throughout the morning, workers will also be hammering stakes into the dirt for erosion prevention.

There is no other outside construction work scheduled for this weekend once this work concludes on Saturday. We will, of course, keep you apprised of future work scheduled in the coming weeks as the project continues toward final completion.
