

## Upper School Summer Biology Teacher

### Responsibilities

It is expected that this position mirror the pacing and content of previous summer biology courses at Head-Royce School. This course is part of the larger Head-Royce School Summer program which serves more than 650 students, kindergarten through high school. The school seeks applicants who have a strong academic background, experience in multicultural education and inquiry-based learning, an awareness of ecological literacy, an understanding of adolescents, and a genuine fondness for working with upper school students.

### Qualifications

The successful candidate will possess a BA in science and advanced degrees/certification are desirable. Teaching experience at the upper school level (grades 9-12) is preferred.
