

11th grade Elective Visualization Worksheet

Need help figuring out which electives would fit into your week next year? Use this worksheet to help you choose ones that fit. Juniors typically have between 4 and 6 free periods each week, depending on elective interests, amount of time spent on outside activities, and learning style.

All juniors take English, History, and a math. Most juniors take a science and a world language. Put each of those classes into a block.
